In the 1930's took the general manager of the Överum iron mills, also the chairman of the local government, the initiative to create a neighborhood where blue-collar and white-collar workers could build their own homes at reasonable costs. He had a vision of a white industrial township. Because of this he wanted all new houses to be white. A lot of the houses have still today the original color. John Håkansson has photographed them all. The book contains of the 125 images, together with a text by the artist and four historical photographs.
